I Have served the past two years as Director Division 3. In the early 1990's I served two terms as Director Division 7

I was secretary/treasurer of the North Louisiana Model Railroad Club for twelve years. The club's primary function was to display and operate the KCS exhibit at the Louisiana State Fair. This was a 24 X 36 fully sceniced HO layout designed to showcase the Kansas City Southern railroad.

I have been a model railroading all of my life starting with Lionel and changing to HO in junior high school. In 1989 I switched to On3, then after a move to the Dallas area added O standard gauge. I am currenting building a dual gauge layout in a 24 X 55 room specially built for that purpose.

I have had 24 articles published in the model railroad press including Model Railroader, Narrow Gauge and Short Line Gazette, O scale resources, O Scale Trains, Marker Lamp and NMRA Bulletin/NMRA Magazine.
