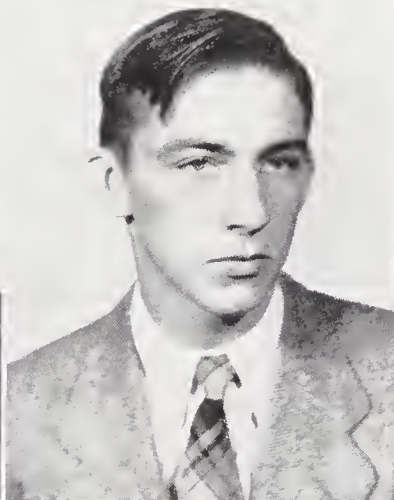
Our class rings which we ordered in October came in the spring.
